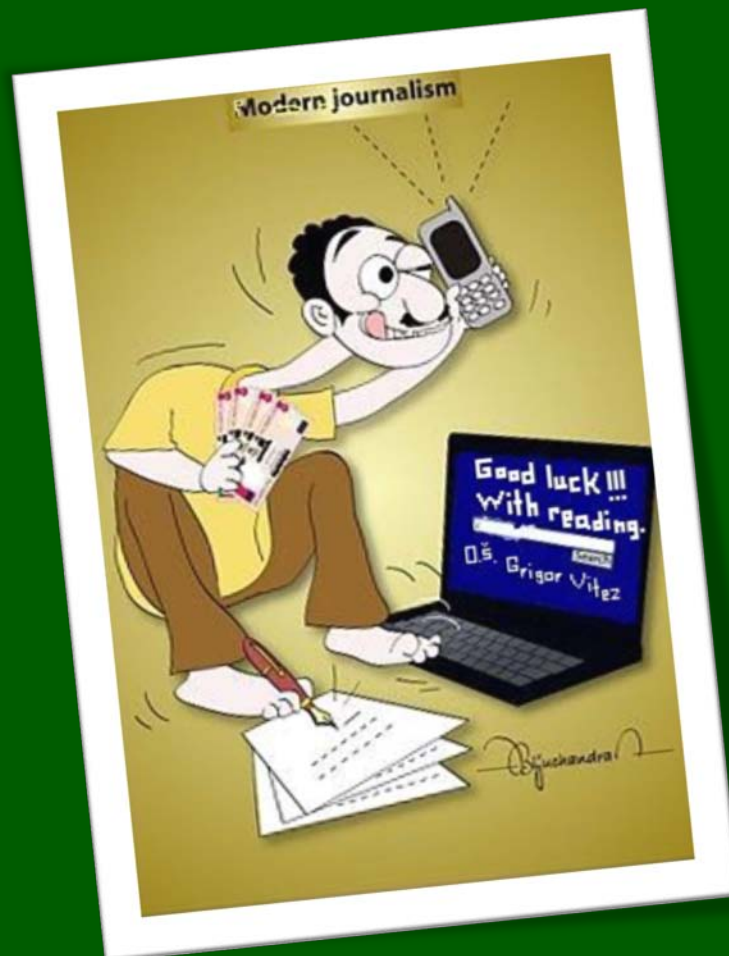

The name Vukovar means "the town on the river Vuka". Vukovar was heavily damaged during the Croatian War of Independence. When we arrived to Vukovar, we went to the hospital. When we entered the hospital, we watched a documentary film about Vukovar. In the film there were real videos from the war. We saw a lot of sick and poor people whose homes were destroyed. When we saw the film, we went to the basement of the hospital. Everything in that basement was exactly the same as it was during the war. The only thing that was different was that they put dolls instead of humans. While we walked through the hospital basement, we heard the voice of Siniša Glavašević. Siniša Glavašević was a Croatian reporter who was killed in the battle of Vukovar. It was later discovered that he was executed by Serbian paramilitary forces along with hundreds of others in the Vukovar massacre. Everything we learned and saw in the hospital was so sad and shocking that some girls even started crying. After we saw the hospital, we went to Ovčara. That is a place where a horrible war crime happened. In that room we could see faces of people who were killed in that place. After that we went to the cemetery. There were still many damaged buildings, even downtown. We had a tour guide who led us through Vukovar and told us about it. It was a very interesting trip because we saw many things and learned a lot about Vukovar.

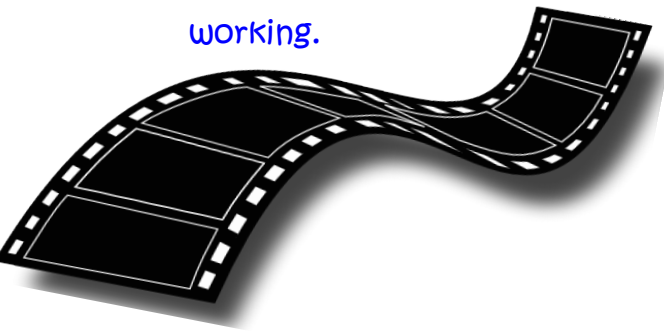




Creative Friday



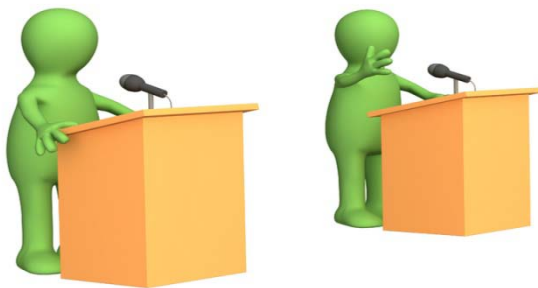

My trip to Tuscany

During All Saints holidays me and my family went on a trip to Tuscany. We visited Florence, Sienna, Pisa and San Gimignano.

Florence

Florence is a city situated in the heart of Tuscany. It's one of the most important cities in the history of Italy and also the capital of Tuscany. Florence is the cradle of Italian Renaissance. We visited a lot of religious monuments such as the church Santa Maria Novella in which we saw Trinity –a famous fresco. We also visited the cathedral called Cattedrale di Santa Maria del Fiore. It is one of the nicest Renaissance buildings in Florence. The most popular museum in Florence is the Uffizi museum which abounds with famous Renaissance paintings among which The Birth of Venus by Botticelli stands out. We visited two palaces: Palazzo Pitti (also a gallery) and Palazzo Vecchio in front of which stands David, the statue made by Michelangelo. Since Florence lies on



the river Arno, we saw a lot of bridges, but the special one is Ponte Vecchio because they built a lot of shops on it. Here is a little advice for gourmands: you have to try their famous Florentine steak.



Sienna

Sienna is a city situated not far from Florence and in the past Florence and Siena were biggest enemies. In the centre of Siena is the square Piazza del Campo that has an interesting shell shape. There we saw the city hall (Palazzo Pubblico) and the famous tower “Torre del Mangia” which is 102 meters high. Piazza del Campo is famous for the horse race Palio that takes place in the square. In Siena we also were in their cathedral (Duomo di Siena). This cathedral should've been the biggest cathedral in



Europe, but plague came while they were building it and killed half of the people in Sienna, so it was never finished.





Pisa

It's a city that lies on the river Arno. Pisa is famous for its cultural heritage. The most important building is the Leaning Tower, one of the Seven Wonders of the World. You can climb on the top of it but we didn't because a lot of people were waiting in the line. In the same square we saw the Cathedral and the Baptistery.

San gimignano

San Gimignano is a little town surrounded by walls. It's famous for its architecture, especially its towers that can be seen from several kilometres outside the town. It's a nice town to take a walk through with your family or to buy Tuscany's products like wine, olive oil, cheese... We also ate ice-cream in a pastry that won the award for the world's best ice-cream.



EUROPEAN CHAMPIONSHIP QUALIFICATIONS



In the qualifications for European championship Croatia played in group F with Greece, Israel, Georgia, Latvia and Malta. At the end of qualifications they were second, behind Greece. They needed to go in two play-off matches against Turkey. Croatian public didn't believe that Croatia can beat Turkey, especially after Greece beat us in our last game in Athens 2 - 0, and they thought that the national team will stay at home in the summer of 2012. Croatia coach Slaven Bilić believed that his players can beat Turkey and qualify for the Championship in Poland and Ukraine. Everybody was talking about our last match with Turkey three years ago in the quarter-finals of the last European Championship in Switzerland and Austria when we lost after penalty shootout. It was time for revenge. The first match took place in one of the major Turkish cities, Istanbul. At the very beginning of the match Croatia scored! Vedran Ćorluka threw the ball into the penalty area and there was Ivica Olić who scored into the empty net of the Turkish goalkeeper. After 30 minutes the score was 0 - 2. Darijo Srna passed the ball to Mandžukić and he scored. After that, there weren't any chances until the fiftieth minute. Free kick for Croatia. Srna passed the ball to Ćorluka and he scored from 5 metres. And that was it.

The next day every Croatian newspaper wrote about the big win last night. Bilić and his players were heroes! The second match was in Zagreb, and Croatia needed another win to get easier opponents in the Championship. People were saying that we were going to the Championship, but Bilić didn't think that way. He said that there were another 90 minutes to play, and after that we can talk about the Championship. On the day of the match the stadium was full. Only four minutes after the match started there was a fantastic chance for Turkey, but Stipe Pletikosa made an excellent save. At half time the score was 0 - 0. Both teams had a few chances. In the second half there was one chance for Ivan Rakitić, but the Turkish goalkeeper showed that it was a very good night for him. Until the end there weren't any special chances, and after the referee blew his whistle for the last time, the happiness could start. Croatia made it through to the European Championship! In the newspapers the next day there were many combinations of the draw: the easiest group, the hardest group... Turkish coach got fired, and Slaven Bilić was the nation's hero. After a failure in the last qualifications for the World Cup, Croatia will go to a big competition again.



KHL MEDVEŠČAK

In the last two months Medveščak made a sensation. They won last 12 out of 13 matches. They beat Jesenice, Vienna and Olimpija two times, and Znojmo, Red Bull, KAC Klagenfurt, Linz, Alba Volan, VSV Villach and Graz one time. The best player is Medveščak's goalie Robert Kristan. In the last period Dario Kostović scored for 4 - 3 but two minutes later Linz scored their fourth goal. In the overtime there were no goals and the winner needed to be decided after penalty shootout. Two out of three Medveščak's players scored and Kristan saved two penalties from Linz



players and the celebration could start! Their next game is in Klagenfurt on Friday against KAC. After that they play against Vienna Capitals in Zagreb.
